Our Attorney, Suellen Fulstone, was magnificent as always in presenting our case. No decision was announced by the State Board at the close of the hearing. We are anticipating that yet another hearing will be called, probably in October. Of course we will keep all of you posted as to any developments as soon as they become known. None of this goes quickly!!
