

Revolters relief

Tax revolters can exhale and reschedule their Tuesday morning as the state supreme court denied the County Board of Equalization's request to review taxable values on some 8,700 properties in Incline Village and Crystal Bay.

"It's another victory," said League to Save Incline Assets President Maryanne Ingemanson. "We were granted our stay by the supreme court yesterday and the hearing has been canceled."

Ingemanson said the announcement yesterday was of particular note as she'd just sent out thousands of flyers reminding property owners to be in court Tuesday in Reno.

"We mailed them all out and an hour later we found out we wouldn't be going to court," she said. "So now it's just getting the word out."
