## NOTICE OF AUDIO/VISUAL HEARING

A Hearing to consider the Settlement Agreement pursuant to this Court's Order Setting Hearing issued September 11, 2020 in this matter is set for October 5, 2020 at 2:00 p.m.

Consistent with the Declaration of Emergency in Nevada, and the Second Judicial District Court Administrative Order 2020-02 ("AO-02") entered on March 16, 2020, and subsequently extended on April 9, 2020 by AO-02(A), on May 19, 2020 by AO-02(B), on June 11, 2020 by AO-02(C) and on July 24, 2020 by AO-02(D), and to support the Washoe County Health Districts efforts to decrease the opportunity for transmission of COVID-19, and Administrative Order 2020-05 ("AO-05") entered March 18, 2020, subsequently extended on May 19, 2020 by AO-05(A), the hearing in this matter shall be held by audio/visual platform.

The hearing will be conducted in accordance with the Nevada Supreme Court Rules Governing Appearance by Audiovisual Transmission Equipment, Part IX-B(A).

Details for the Zoom Webinar hearing are attached hereto as Exhibit 1 to the Notice of Audio/Visual Hearing. In addition, counsel, parties, and public (unless the hearing is closed by Rule, Statute, or Order to the public) may access the Zoom Webinar link by accessing www.washoecourts.com, clicking on "Online-Hearings-Click here to select the department" and scrolling down to Department 1.

Pursuant to AO 2020-02(A), the parties are reminded that although conducted on an audio/visual platform, a hearing is a formal proceeding and shall be conducted with proper decorum.<sup>1</sup> Appropriate attire is required.

If any party intends to introduce exhibits during the hearing, the exhibits must be E-filed with the Court no later than three business days prior to the hearing. E-filing documents for a hearing shall not waive the adverse party's ability to object to any such document, nor does such filing mean the document is evidence until it is admitted by the Court. Any videos, thumb drives, CD's, and/or DVD's must be lodged by the Filing Office. You may do this by either dropping off your exhibit at the drop box located at 1 S. Sierra Street, Reno, Nevada, with your directives for the Filing Office to lodge the exhibit with the Evidence Clerk. You may also mail your exhibit to the Filing Office at 75 Court Street, Reno, Nevada, 89501, with your directives. Submitting party is responsible to provide opposing party with the same and will be responsible for the screen sharing during the audio/visual hearing.

Any party who objects to the matter being heard in this manner, must e-file their Objection to Audiovisual Transmission Conducted Hearing with a contemporaneously e-filed Request for Submission of the Objection **no later than two business days prior to the hearing**. The Court may or may not vacate the hearing based upon the reasons given for the objection. Unless and until a new order is entered vacating this hearing, the matter will proceed as noticed herein.

## SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT PROTOCOLS

## BEHAVE AS YOU WOULD IN A PHYSICAL COURTROOM

## Dress appropriately.

Dress as if attending church or a job interview. You may also wear your work uniform or clothing, if you are joining court on a work break.

No hats or sunglasses.

Choose a quiet place to attend Court. Cellphones should be muted, doors to rooms closed, and disruptions minimized.

Be aware of your Zoom background and the area behind you. Avoid distractions. No playful virtual backgrounds are allowed, such as Hawaii or Space.

Try not to sit directly in front of or behind a window. The the light or reflection can affect the video.

Log on fifteen (15) minutes early for your Court hearing. The Courtroom Clerk will admit you when ready.

Turn off your microphones and camera after checking in with the Clerk.

Do not smoke, eat, or drink while you are participating in Court via Zoom.

Do not walk around on the phone while you are participating in Court via Zoom. Remain seated or standing still.

Do not drive while participating in Court via Zoom.

If you are in a vehicle, safely pull over then stop the vehicle before participating in Court via Zoom.

Do not speak over or interrupt anyone. Use appropriate language, just as you would in a physical courtroom.

Keep your microphone and camera off until your case is called.

Once your hearing is over, turn off your microphone and camera.

Only you, attorneys, or other people the Judge requests will be allowed to talk to the Judge.

Address the Judge as "Your Honor" or "Judge." Family members and friends may not speak to the Judge.

If there is a court reporter or language interpreter present, he or she may interrupt to clarify who is speaking.

If you do not follow the Court's rules, you may be removed from the Court hearing, and the Judge may impose other sanctions.
